Rose,

You have already received by e-mail the draft amendment to require use of cooperative purchasing for grant recipients. I'm not sure how to draft everything related to procurement, so some of what is in the draft is suggestions for you and Mark Kunkle to think about. Let me share a few comments on it for you.

The draft could apply to all purchases, or (as indicated in brackets) leases and service contracts, as well. I think you probably want to include the latter, though they differ a little from the language in par. (c) ("purchase, lease, operate and maintain").

John and I were unsure whether it is necessary to include a requirement that DEG do anything, or rely on its current statutes to ensure that it helps local governments looking for these purchasing contracts--we erred on the side of more language rather than less, but again you and Mark can evaluate whether it is needed or desired.

Not sure how strong to be in the requirement that grant recipients do this, and not entirely sure what the difference is between "practical" and "practicable"--I *think* that the former means what we understand it to mean, while the latter means "able to be put into practice" and so is a stronger requirement.

I'll be around tomorrow (after a morning meeting), if you have questions.

6 **2.** Page 3, line 1: delete "SECTION 1." and substitute "SECTION 1m.".

8 "5. To the <sup>greatest</sup> extent ~~practical~~ [practicable], a local government that receives a grant under  
9 this paragraph shall make all purchases [, leases or service contracts] under the grant through  
10 purchasing contracts of the department of electronic government or a purchasing consortium  
11 of local governments.".
