


1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 1. Page 8, line 9: delete lines 9 to 14 and substitute:

3 "146.70 (7) ~~TELECOMMUNICATIONS UTILITY NOT LIABLE~~ LIABILITY EXEMPTION. A
4 telecommunications utility, wireless provider, as defined in sub. (3m) (a) 6., or local
5 government, as defined in sub. (3m) (a) 4., shall not be liable to any person who uses
6 an emergency number system created under this section or makes an emergency
7 telephone call initially routed to a wireless public safety answering point, as defined
8 in sub. (3m) (a) 7."
