**ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 2,  
TO 2003 ASSEMBLY BILL 42**

February 18, 2003 - Offered by Representatives MUSSER and PETTIS.

1 **AN ACT to amend** 45.358 (3) (f) of the statutes; **relating to:** eligibility for burial  
2 in a veterans cemetery.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

3 **SECTION 1.** 45.358 (3) (f) of the statutes is amended to read:

4 45.358 (3) (f) A person who was a resident of this state at the time of his or her  
5 entry or reentry into service in ~~the Wisconsin army national guard or air~~ any national  
6 guard or in a reserve component of the U.S. armed forces or ~~at the time of~~ who was  
7 a resident of this state for at least 12 consecutive months immediately preceding his  
8 or her death and who has 20 or more years of creditable military service for  
9 retirement pay as a member of the Wisconsin army national guard or air national  
10 guard or a reserve component of the U.S. armed forces or who would have been  
11 entitled to that retirement pay except that the person was under 60 years of age at

1 ~~the time of his or her death~~, and the person's spouse, surviving spouse and dependent  
2 children, if the person is eligible for burial in a national cemetery under 38 USC 2402.
