

2003 ASSEMBLY BILL 12

AN ACT *to amend* 28.05 (1); and *to create* 28.045 of the statutes; **relating to:**
educational requirements for field foresters employed by the Department of
Natural Resources and persons authorized to designate trees for cutting in
state forests.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

1 **SECTION 1.** 28.045 of the statutes is created to read:
2 **28.045 Educational requirements for field foresters.** (1) Every person
3 hired as a field forester by the department on or after the effective date of this
4 subsection [revisor inserts date], shall have received a bachelor's or higher degree
5 in forestry from a school of forestry with a curriculum accredited by the Society of
6 American Foresters or an equivalent degree, as determined by the chief state
7 forester.
