

**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1,  
TO 2003 ASSEMBLY BILL 388**

June 19, 2003 – Offered by COMMITTEE ON TRANSPORTATION.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 1, line 5: delete “The department” and substitute “(1) The  
3 department”.

4 **2.** Page 1, line 5: after “and” insert “, subject to sub. (2),”. 1-5

5 **3.** Page 2, line 2: after that line insert:

6 **(2)** Upon receipt of sufficient contributions from interested parties, including  
7 any county, city, village, or town, to cover the costs of erecting and maintaining  
8 markers at the bridge specified in sub. (1) to clearly identify to motorists the  
9 designation of the bridge as “Freedoms Bridge,” the department shall erect and  
10 maintain the markers. No state funds, other than from the receipt of contributions  
11 under this subsection, may be expended for the erection or maintenance of the  
12 markers.”
