1 AN ACT *relating to* Registration plates for veterans wounded in combat.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

2 SECTION 1. 341.13 (2r) of the statutes is created to read:

3 341.13 (2r) In addition to the matter specified in s. 341.12 (3), the registration  
4 plates for a vehicle registered under s. 341.14 (6r) (f) 32. shall display the words  
5 "combat-wounded veteran." The department shall specify one combination of colors  
6 and design for a plate issued under s. 341.14 (6r) (f) 32., except that the department  
7 may not specify the colors or design unless the colors and design are approved in  
8 writing by the state department of veterans affairs.

9 SECTION 2. 341.135 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

10 341.135 (1) DESIGN. Every 7th year, the department shall establish new  
11 designs of registration plates to be issued under ss. 341.14 (1a), (1m), (1q), (2), (2m),

1 (6m), and (6r), 341.25 (1) (a), (c), (h), and (j) and (2) (a), (b), and (c), and 341.26 (2) and  
 2 (3) (a) 1. and (am). Any design for registration plates issued for automobiles and for  
 3 vehicles registered on the basis of gross weight shall comply with the applicable  
 4 design requirements of ss. 341.12 (3), 341.13, and 341.14 (6r) (c). The designs for  
 5 registration plates specified in this subsection shall be as similar in appearance as  
 6 practicable during each 7-year design interval. ~~Each~~ Except as provided in s. 341.13  
 7 (2r), each registration plate issued under s. 341.14 (1a), (1m), (1q), (2), (2m), (6m), or  
 8 (6r), 341.25 (1) (a), (c), (h), or (j) or (2) (a), (b), or (c), or 341.26 (2) or (3) (a) 1. or (am)  
 9 during each 7-year design interval shall be of the design established under this  
 10 subsection. The department may not redesign registration plates for the special  
 11 groups under s. 341.14 (6r) (f) 53., 54., or 55. until July 1, 2007. Except for  
 12 registration plates issued under s. 341.14 (6r) (f) 53., 54., or 55., the first design cycle  
 13 for registration plates issued under ss. 341.14 (1a), (1m), (1q), (2), (2m), (6m), and  
 14 (6r), 341.25 (1) (a), (c), (h), and (j) and (2) (a), (b), and (c), and 341.26 (2) and (3) (a)  
 15 1. and (am) began July 1, 2000.
