- 3 346.74 **(5)** (c) Is guilty of a Class I <u>E</u> felony if the accident involved injury to a person and the person suffered great bodily harm.
- 5 **SECTION 2.** 346.74 (5) (d) of the statutes, as affected by 2001 Wisconsin Act 109, is amended to read:
- 7 346.74 **(5)** (d) Is guilty of a Class H <u>D</u> felony if the accident involved death to a person.
