resources for which the department has granted a waiver or an exemption under s. 1 2 289.43 (3), (4), (7), or (8) or that is exempt by rule promulgated under s. 289.05 (4). 3 **SECTION 4.** 895.58 (2) of the statutes is amended to read: 4 895.58 (2) The department may characterize a solid special waste as suitable 5 for beneficial use in public works projects by rule, memorandum of understanding 6 between itself and other state agencies or local governmental units, or on a 7 case-by-case basis. The department shall compile and maintain a list of special 8 wastes that are suitable for use in specified types of public works projects in a format 9 readily available to the general public and only those special wastes may be required 10 by contracting agencies to be used in a public works project. The list may include 11 conditions under which the special waste may be used in the public works project in 12 order for subs. (3) and (4) to be applicable. The list under this subsection is not a rule 13 under s. 227.01 (13). 14 **SECTION 5.** 895.58 (3) of the statutes is amended to read: 15 895.58 (3) Special waste, when used in a public works project, is not subject to 16 exempt from regulation as solid waste under ch. 289 if all of the applicable conditions 17 included in the list complied under sub. (2) are met. 18 (END)
