## **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

Under current law, property taxes that are paid prior to January 31 are paid to the taxation district treasurer; after January 31, property taxes are paid to the county treasurer.

Under the bill, the taxation district treasurer or county treasurer may designate one or more public depositories to collect property taxes. Thus, taxpayers would have the option to pay their property taxes to the appropriate treasurer or to a designated bank. The bill would provide minimal municipal and county savings to the extent that fewer taxpayers would pay their taxes to the treasurer.
