

## 2003 SENATE BILL 121

AN ACT relating to: disposal of oil-absorbent materials.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

1           **SECTION 1. Nonstatutory provisions.**

2           (1) DISPOSAL OF OIL-ABSORBENT MATERIALS.

3           (a) No later than the first day of the 9th month beginning after the effective date  
4 of this paragraph, the secretary of commerce shall appoint and convene a committee  
5 under section 15.04 (1) (c) of the statutes to do all of the following:

6           1. Gather data concerning the following:

7           a. The number of oil filters used in this state annually.

8           b. The number of used oil filters recycled in this state annually.

9           c. The amount of oil-absorbent material disposed of in this state annually.

1           d. The amount of oil-absorbent material recycled or recovered in this state  
2 annually.

3           2. Establish percentage goals for recycling used oil filters and for recycling or  
4 recovering other oil-absorbent materials that are enough higher than current  
5 practice to make a significant difference but are attainable with current technology.

6           3. Set a deadline for meeting the goals under subdivision 2.

7           4. Suggest measures to be taken if the goals under subdivision 2. are not met  
8 and dates for taking those measures.

9           (am) The secretary of commerce shall appoint the following members to the  
10 committee under paragraph (a):

11           1. A representative of Associated Recyclers of Wisconsin or National Oil  
12 Recyclers of America.

13           2. A representative of the Federation of Environmental Technologists.

14           3. A representative of the council on recycling.

15           4. A representative of the Automotive Service Association.

16           5. A representative of the petroleum industry.

17           6. A representative of the Wisconsin Automobile and Truck Dealers  
18 Association.

19           7. A representative of landfill owners or operators.

20           8. A representative of the University of Wisconsin System.

21           9. A representative of the department of natural resources.

22           10. A representative of scrap brokers, dealers, or processors.

23           11. A representative of oil filter manufacturers.

24           12. A representative of the Wisconsin Counties Association.
