AN ACT relating to: disposal of oil-absorbent materials.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill requires the secretary of commerce to appoint a committee to study the use and disposal of used oil filters and other oil—absorbent materials, to establish percentage goals for recycling used oil filters and for recycling or recovering other oil—absorbent materials, and to recommend measures to be taken if those goals are not met.
