# 2001 SENATE BILL 488

March 6, 2002 – Introduced by Senator HARSDORF, cosponsored by Representative PLOUFF, by request of the Department of Natural Resources Council on Recycling. Referred to Committee on Environmental Resources.

1 AN ACT relating to: disposal of oil-absorbant materials.

***Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau***

This bill requires the secretary of commerce to appoint a committee to study the use and disposal of used oil filters and other oil-absorbant materials, to establish percentage goals for recycling used oil filters and for recycling or recovering other oil-absorbant materials, and to recommend measures to be taken if those goals are not met.

***The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:***

2 SECTION 1. Nonstatutory provisions.

14 (c) The department shall submit recommendations based on the work of the  
15 committee under paragraph (a) *a.r.* to the chief clerk of each house of the legislature for  
16 distribution in the manner provided in section 13.172 (2) of the statutes and to the  
17 governor no later than the first day of the 25th month beginning after the effective  
18 date of this paragraph.
