Jeff:

I've spoken with Rep. Freese about most of the other bills. Here's what we've decided.

✓ There is no need to redraft 2001 AB 10, AB 12, AB 39 and AB 49.
Please draft AB 40 with AA1 to AA1, AA1, AA2 and AA3.

→ We are not requesting AB 39 under the assumption that you and Kevin Kennedy will have a HAVA draft ready to go.

With regard to the absentee ballot issue you raised in LRB 0773/1dn, an elector would be required to submit in the ballot a copy of their driver's license or DOT issued photo ID. Clerks would be required to include information about this requirement in the absentee ballot mailed out (if need be, the Elections Board would design and regulate how the information is presented). I believe this measure would solve any constitutional questions. Do you agree?

TRANS A

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law requires the elections board to conduct regular information and training meetings at various locations in the state for county and municipal clerks and other election officials. In addition, each municipal clerk must instruct election officials in their duties. ~~Although current law does not require election officials to be certified,~~ the governing body of any municipality may require all persons serving as election officials in that municipality to prove their ability to read and write English and to have a general knowledge of the election laws. A municipality may administer examinations to determine whether these qualifications are met.

This bill directs the elections board to prepare recommendations with regard to ~~establishing~~ a program for the ^{recruitment and} training and certification of election officials. The ~~elections~~ board must submit the recommendations to the legislature for distribution to the appropriate standing committees of both houses by ~~April 10, 2002.~~

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Nonstatutory provisions.

(1) The elections board shall prepare recommendations with regard to ^{recruitment and} ~~establishing~~ a program for the training and certification of election officials. No later



Currently, municipalities must pay reasonable compensation to election officials, unless an election official chooses to volunteer his or her services.

Currently, effective September 1, 2004, no individual may serve as a chief inspector (chief poll worker) at a polling place unless the individual is certified by the elections board to hold that office on the date of the election at which the individual serves. The board establishes requirements for certification, conducts regular training, and administers examinations to individuals to determine whether they meet the requirements. The board pays the cost of conducting the training and administering the examinations. Officials and trainees are compensated by municipalities for attendance at training sessions and examinations.
