

**ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,
TO 2003 ASSEMBLY BILL 592**

1 **AN ACT relating to:** supplemental Medical Assistance payments to county, city,
2 town, or village nursing homes.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1. Nonstatutory provisions.**

4 (1) SUPPLEMENTAL PAYMENTS TO NURSING HOMES.

5 (a) Notwithstanding the limitation under section 49.45 (6u) (am) (intro.) of the
6 statutes on supplemental payments for reduction of operating deficits incurred by
7 nursing homes owned or operated by counties, cities, villages, or towns, in fiscal
8 years 2003–04 and 2004–05, the department of health and family services shall from
9 the appropriation under section 20.435 (4) (w) of the statutes distribute for this

1 purpose, under criteria specified in section 49.45 (6u) (am) 1. to 7. of the statutes, any
2 additional federal Medical Assistance moneys received, based on the funds of
3 counties, cities, villages, and towns that are transferred to the Medical Assistance
4 trust fund, certified under 42 CFR 433.51 (b), reimbursed under section 20.435 (4)
5 (wp) of the statutes, and used as the nonfederal share of Medical Assistance funding,
6 that were not anticipated and budgeted as revenue under 2003 Wisconsin Act 33.

7 (b) Any additional federal Medical Assistance moneys received under
8 paragraph (a) may not be included in the base of an appropriation account under
9 section 20.435 (4) of the statutes for the purpose of determining the adjusted base
10 funding level for the department of health and family services for fiscal year
11 2005–06.
