Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

SB 204 requires OCI to promulgate a rule that would divide Wisconsin into 5 geographic areas for the purpose of organizing health care purchasing coops. While there is an expense for developing and promulgating any administrative rule, it is possible for OCI to absorb those costs within OCI's existing budget.

Local Government costs are indeterminate. It is not possible to determine what cooperative health purchasing groups will be charging for health insurance premiums to determine if this will provide enough incentive for Local Government entities to shift their health care purchasing decisions.
