A couple of additional technical clean-ups:

- cc or the* Section 150, page 48, lines 4-5 -- "under" at the end of line 4 should be moved to before "this subchapter" on line 5

*cc or the* These changes are in addition to the double use of s. 30.12 (1m) and the two consistency items I mentioned earlier and that you were going to check on:

- AB* 1) I think we need to change the language on p. 48, lines 18-20, to include "significant adverse impacts or" after "prevent" on line 20. This is to be consistent with the change on p. 49, line 25.
- but see* 2) We should also clarify that the new language regarding state holidays in sections 202 (p. 71, line 5) and 212 (p. 74, line 7) is added to sections 205 (p. 71, line 22) and 215 (p. 74, line 24).
