

**SENATE AMENDMENT 6,  
TO 2003 ASSEMBLY BILL 655**

January 20, 2004 - Offered by Senators WIRCH, HANSEN, CHVALA, MOORE, COGGS, CARPENTER, M. MEYER, DECKER, ERPENBACH, RISSER, JAUCH, BRESKE, ROBSON and LASSA.

1           At the locations indicated, amend the bill, as shown by assembly substitute  
2 amendment 2, as follows:

3           **1.** Page 3, line 10: delete “and granting rule-making authority” and substitute  
4 “increasing funding for local youth apprenticeship grants and increasing positions  
5 for the Governor’s Work-Based Learning Board; granting rule-making authority;  
6 and making appropriations”.

7           **2.** Page 3, line 11: delete that line and substitute:

8           “**SECTION 1d.** 20.445 (1) (e) of the statutes, as affected by 2003 Wisconsin Act  
9 33, is renumbered 20.445 (7) (b).

10          **SECTION 1t.** 29.601 (5) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:”.

11          **3.** Page 53, line 10: after that line insert:

12          “**SECTION 157m.** 106.13 (1) of the statutes, as affected by 2003 Wisconsin Act  
13 33, is amended to read:

1           106.13 (1) The department board shall provide a youth apprenticeship  
2 program that includes the grant programs under subs. (3m) and (4).

3           **SECTION 157n.** 106.13 (3m) (b) (intro.) of the statutes, as affected by 2003  
4 Wisconsin Act 33, is amended to read:

5           106.13 (3m) (b) (intro.) From the appropriation under s. 20.445 ~~(1) (e)~~ (7) (b),  
6 the board shall award grants to applying local partnerships for the implementation  
7 and coordination of local youth apprenticeship programs. A local partnership shall  
8 include in its grant application the identity of each public agency, nonprofit  
9 organization, individual, and other person who is a participant in the local  
10 partnership, a plan to accomplish the implementation and coordination activities  
11 specified in subs. 1. to 6., and the identity of a fiscal agent who shall be responsible  
12 for receiving, managing, and accounting for the grant moneys received under this  
13 paragraph. Subject to par. (c), a local partnership that is awarded a grant under this  
14 paragraph may use the grant moneys awarded for any of the following  
15 implementation and coordination activities:".

16           **4.** Page 81, line 24: after that line insert:

17           **"SECTION 231m. Appropriation changes.**

18           (1) GOVERNOR'S WORK-BASED LEARNING BOARD. In the schedule under section  
19 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation to the department of workforce  
20 development under section 20.445 (1) (a) of the statutes, as affected by the acts of  
21 2003, the dollar amount is increased by \$230,000 for fiscal year 2004-05 to increase  
22 the authorized FTE positions for the department by 2.0 GPR positions for the  
23 performance of services for the governor's work-based learning board.
