3 **1.** Page 9, line 16: after that line insert:

4 “SECTION 22m. 30.12 (1h) of the statutes is created to read:

5 30.12 (1h) EXEMPTIONS; EFFECTIVE DATE. The exemptions under sub. (1g) do not
6 take effect until the day after ^{1st of the 12th month after} any rule promulgated under sub. (1m) takes effect.”.

7 **2.** Page 9, line 18: delete “(a)”.

8 **3.** Page 9, line 20: substitute “(a)” for “1.”.

9 **4.** Page 9, line 21: after “impacts” insert “and to protect public rights in
10 navigable waters”.

11 **5.** Page 9, line 22: substitute “(b)” for “2.”.

12 **6.** Page 10, line 1: substitute “(c)” for “3.”.

1 (c) The department shall require that the person intending to engage in the
2 exempt activity apply for an individual permit or contract, or seek authorization
3 under a general permit, if the department determines that conditions specific to the
4 site require restrictions on the activity in order to prevent any of the following:

- 5 1. A detrimental impact to the public rights or interests.
- 6 2. Environmental pollution, as defined in s. 299.01 (4).
- 7 3. Material injury to the riparian rights of any riparian owner.
- 8 4. Material obstruction to navigation.

9 (d) If the department requires that person apply for an individual permit or
10 contract or seek authorization under a general permit, the department shall notify
11 the person in writing which individual permit, contract, or general permit will be
12 required for the activity. If the department does not require that the person apply
13 or seek authorization, the department need not provide the person any notice.

14 (e) If a statement under par. (a) does not give consent to inspect, the 30-day
15 time limit under par. (b) does not apply.”.

16 **6.** Page 41, line 16: delete that line and substitute:

17 “**SECTION 134m.** 30.206 (1) (c) 1. to 4. of the statutes are created to read:”.

18 **7.** Page 41, line 22: after that line insert:

19 “4. Restrictions to protect public rights or interests in navigable waters.”.

20 **8.** Page 52, line 3: delete that line and substitute “(2m), 30.123 (6m), or 30.20
21 (1m), whether a general permit is”.

22 **9.** Page 82, line 20: after that line insert:

23 “**SECTION 233. Effective date.**”
