Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill allows a sheriff or jailer to receive a copy of competency examination reports about individuals under their care and control. The reports may then be shared with health care workers providing services to the jail.

Wisconsin jails currently evaluate and treat the health and mental health needs of the individuals under their care and control, based upon those evaluations. While these reports may provide additional information, it is assumed the resulting treatment (and thus the costs) will not change.

This bill has not fiscal impact on the Department of Corrections.
