TO 2003 SENATE BILL 6**

September 25, 2003 - Offered by COMMITTEE ON HOMELAND SECURITY, VETERANS AND
MILITARY AFFAIRS AND GOVERNMENT REFORM.

1 **AN ACT to create** 77.54 (47) of the statutes; **relating to:** creating a sales tax and
2 use tax exemption for the sale of game birds and clay pigeons.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do
enact as follows:*

3 **SECTION 1.** 77.54 (47) of the statutes is created to read:

4 77.54 (47) The gross receipts from the sale of and the storage, use, or other
5 consumption of live game birds, and clay pigeons, that are sold to bird hunting
6 preserves licensed under s. 169.19.

7 **SECTION 2. Initial applicability.**

8 (1) This act first applies to sales made on January 1, 2003.

9 **SECTION 3. Effective date.**

10 (1) This act takes effect retroactively to January 1, 2003.
