

2003 ASSEMBLY BILL 202

March 25, 2003 – Introduced by Representatives STONE, HUNDERTMARK, AINSWORTH, ALBERS, BIES, HAHN, HINES, JESKEWITZ, KRAWCZYK, LADWIG, MUSSER, SERATTI, STASKUNAS, WARD, WEBER and ZIEGELBAUER, cosponsored by Senators LAZICH and SCHULTZ. Referred to Committee on Small Business.

1 **AN ACT** *to create* 118.12 (5) of the statutes; **relating to:** school board contracts
2 for yearbook photographs.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill provides that if a school board contracts with a person to provide photographs of 12th grade pupils for a school yearbook the contract may not prohibit a pupil from supplying his or her own photograph for the yearbook, subject to the school board's reasonable specifications.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1.** 118.12 (5) of the statutes is created to read:
4 118.12 (5) If a school board contracts with a person to provide photographs of
5 12th grade pupils for a school yearbook, the contract may not prohibit a pupil from
6 supplying his or her own photograph for the yearbook, subject to the school board's
7 reasonable specifications.
