According to the information supplied by Milwaukee:

The City of Milwaukee has entered into towing contracts pursuant to Section 101-25.5 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances, and it is the City that provides the notice to registered owners or lienholders.

Thus, they would like an exception for local units of government that have contracted with towing services, but have retained the responsibility for the giving of notice pursuant to statute or ordinance.
