Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

If enacted, this bill would add certain reporting requirements to ensure the accuracy, integrity, and consistency of the data that agencies use when preparing administrative rules. This estimate assumes that DOA would develop a standardized format for agencies to identify data sources used in developing an administrative rule. It also assumes that DOA's State Budget Office would review each rule to ensure that all data sources have been identified and reported accurately. Based on the last 5 years, 175 administrative rules are promulgated annually.

Administrative rules vary considerably in complexity and reliance on data to support the rule requirements. Because of this wide variation the department cannot estimate how much additional time would be required of rule making agencies to implement this provision.
