Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill directs the governor to annually proclaim February as African American History and Cultural Heritage Month as a way to recognize and celebrate the contributions and achievements of African Americans.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

4 **SECTION 1.** 14.16 (12) of the statutes is created to read:
5 **14.16 (12) AFRICAN AMERICAN HISTORY AND CULTURAL HERITAGE MONTH.** The
6 governor shall annually proclaim February as African American History and
7 Cultural Heritage Month as a way to recognize and celebrate the contributions and
8 achievements of African Americans.
