2003 WISCONSIN ACT 149

AN ACT *to amend* 36.11 (22) (a) 1. (intro.) and 2. of the statutes; **relating to:** providing certain orientation information for University of Wisconsin System students electronically.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 36.11 (22) (a) 1. (intro.) and 2. of the statutes are amended to read:

36.11 (22) (a) 1. (intro.) Incorporate in its orientation program for newly entering students oral and written or

<u>electronic</u> information on sexual assault and sexual harassment, as defined in s. 111.32 (13), including information on sexual assault by acquaintances of the victims and on all of the following:

2. Annually supply to all students enrolled in the institution or college campus printed <u>or electronic</u> material that includes all of the information under par. (a).
