

## 2003 SENATE BILL 247

September 17, 2003 – Introduced by Senators HARSDORF, KANAVAS, SCHULTZ, ROESSLER and REYNOLDS, cosponsored by Representatives JESKEWITZ, GRONEMUS, KERKMAN, LADWIG, WEBER, ALBERS, KREIBICH, HINES, OLSEN, RHOADES, BIES, GOTTLIEB, GUNDERSON, KRAWCZYK, TAYLOR, F. LASEE, VAN ROY, CULLEN, OWENS, SERATTI, HUNDERTMARK and HAHN. Referred to Committee on Higher Education and Tourism.

### *Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau*

Current law requires the Board of Regents of the University of Wisconsin System (system) to ensure that each system institution incorporates into its orientation program for new students oral and written information on sexual assault and sexual harassment and to supply annually all students enrolled in the system with printed material that includes this information. This bill allows the system to supply the required written or printed information in electronic format.
