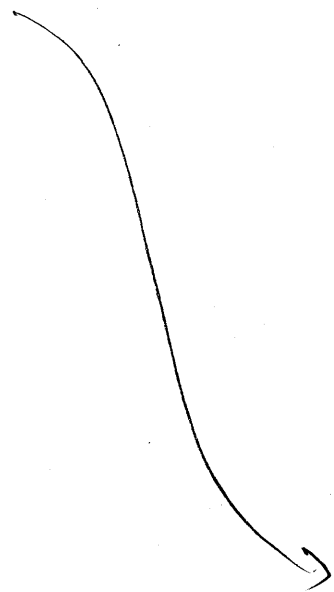

ASSEMBLY BILL 747

Include Marva Collins Preparatory and DL Hines Academy Schools

Motion:

Move to add Marva Collins Preparatory and DL Hines Academy to AB 747 and allow pupils who attended these schools prior to 2002-03 as private school pupils to continue to attend as charter pupils, regardless of the pupil's district of residence or prior year enrollment status. In addition, if the pupil's sibling attended one of the schools prior to 2002-03, and in the school year of the pupil's initial attendance, allow the pupil to attend as well.

Note:

Woodlands School will be the third Milwaukee parental choice school to convert to an independent charter school when it opens in 2004-05. Marva Collins Preparatory and D.L. Hines Academy both converted from choice to charter schools in 2002-03. Similar to some Woodlands School pupils, some Marva Collins and D.L. Hines pupils were ineligible to attend independent charter schools, under current law prior year enrollment and residency criteria. The motion would allow those formerly private school pupils to attend these schools, and allow the schools to collect state charter school payments on behalf of those pupils.
