Hi Bob,

Rep. Musser asked me to request a sub. amdt. to AB 409 (CVSO duties). I've done the following draft based on his discussion with Marlene and me. You'll see that he wants to require DMA to provide certain info to DVA for dissemination to CVSOs, but make it permissive that the CVSOs provide the specified information and assistance to guard and reserves members and their families, hoping to avoid over-burdening the CVSOs.

Call me if you have questions about my wording and please send me an electronic copy when it's ready, as well as to Rep. Musser and Marlene. I think he plans to exec it on Sept. 17. I'll be gone Sep. 12th through 15th, so if I could see the sub by the 11th or sooner, that would be great.

SECTION 1. 21.19 (13) of the statutes is created to read:

21.19(13) The adjutant general shall provide to the department of veterans affairs, for dissemination to the county veterans' service officers, information on all necessary military points of contact and general deployment information for activated and deployed members of the national guard or a reserve unit of the U.S. armed forces, in accordance with s. 45.43 (5m), Stats.

SECTION 2. 45.43 (5m) of the statutes is created to read:

45.43 (5m) PERMITTED ACTIVITIES. The county veterans' service officer may:

(a) Inform persons living in the service officer's county who are members of the national guard or of a reserve unit of the U.S. armed forces or dependents of those persons regarding potential benefits to which they may be or become entitled, all necessary military points of contact and general deployment

information for activated and deployed personnel, and render to them and their dependents all possible assistance.

(b) Cooperate with federal and state agencies which serve or grant aids or benefits to members of the national guard and members of a reserve unit of the U.S. armed forces and their dependents.
