Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law designates a variety of state symbols and requires the Wisconsin Blue Book to include information about them. This bill designates the cranberry as the Wisconsin state fruit and requires the Wisconsin Blue Book to include that information.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1.** 1.10 (3) (r) of the statutes is created to read:

4 1.10 (3) (r) The cranberry (*vaccinium macrocarpon*) is the state fruit.

5 **SECTION 2.** 1.10 (4) of the statutes is amended to read:

6 1.10 (4) The Wisconsin Blue Book shall include the information contained in
