Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, if a person owes a debt related to unpaid fines, fees, or forfeitures to a county or municipality, the county or municipality may certify the debt to the Department of Revenue (DOR) so that DOR may collect the debt for the county or municipality by subtracting the amount of the debt from any tax refund owed to the debtor. Under the bill, a county or municipality may certify any debt that is at least \$20, other than property tax—related debt, to DOR so that DOR may collect the debt for the county or municipality by subtracting the amount of the debt from any tax refund owed to the debtor.

For further information see the *state and local* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.
