Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This legislation will increase the number of individuals who can receive nonresident tuition exemptions. It is not possible, at present, to determine the number of individuals who will fall into the proposed category and who would choose to attend UW institutions. For any individual who is eligible as per the proposed legislation, UW will lose approximately \$10,000 per year (the difference between resident and non-resident tuition).
