RE: Amendment to AB 14

AB 14 relates to notification of law enforcement when a sex offender changes residence, employment or school. You asked me to summarize what should be included in an amendment to AB 14 to implement the recommendations outlined in my previous memorandum of January 22nd.

I would eliminate all references in the bill to written notification of law enforcement. I recommend that an amendment be drafted that requires DOC to make information relating to changes to residence, employment or school available to law enforcement on DOC's Secure Sex Offender Registry Web site. This change should be drafted to s. 301.46 (2) WI Stats; and all references in the current bill to 301.46 (2m) should be deleted. Sub (2) relates to access for law enforcement agencies while sub (2m) relates to special bulletins to law enforcement. This bill is intended to apply to all sex offenders listed in the registry on the web site designed for law enforcement and not just special bulletin cases.

The delayed effective date of the first day of the 6th month after publication should be retained (section 10 of AB 14). This will provide us with the time to make technological changes to our web site for law enforcement. An applicability section is not necessary (section 11 of bill) because historical information on changes will be available to law enforcement upon inquiry.

If the drafter in the Legislative Reference Bureau has any questions on our intent, I would be happy to answer them. It would be helpful if we could review any amendment before it is introduced.



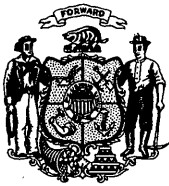
