11	943.10 (2) (c) While <u>the person is</u> in the burglarized enclosure <u>, he or she</u> opens,
12	or attempts to open, any depository by use of an explosive ; or<u>.</u>
13	SECTION 7. 943.10 (2) (d) of the statutes is amended to read:
14	943.10 (2) (d) While the person is in the burglarized enclosure, he or she
15	commits a battery upon a person lawfully therein.
16	SECTION 8. 943.10 (2) (e) of the statutes is created to read:
17	943.10 (2) (e) The burglarized enclosure is a dwelling, boat, or motor home and
18	another person is lawfully present in the dwelling, boat, or motor home at the time
19	of the violation.
20	SECTION 9. Effective date.
