1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 2, line 14: delete the material beginning with that line and ending with
3 page 5, line 2 and substitute:

4 **"SECTION 2m.** 941.375 of the statutes is created to read:

5 **941.375 Throwing or discharging bodily fluids at public safety**
6 **workers.** (1) In this section:

7 (a) "Ambulance" has the meaning specified in s. 146.50 (1) (am).

8 (b) "Public safety worker" means an emergency medical technician licensed
9 under s. 146.50, a first responder certified under s. 146.50 (8), a peace officer, a fire
10 fighter, or a person operating or staffing an ambulance.

11 (2) Any person who throws or expels blood, semen, vomit, saliva, urine, feces,
12 or other bodily substance at or toward a public safety worker under all of the
13 following circumstances is guilty of a Class I felony:
