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2003 ASSEMBLY BILL 556

October 2, 2003 - Introduced by Representatives WASSERMAN, GUNDERSON, KAUFERT, ALBERS, GROTHMAN, HAHN, JESKEWITZ, MUSSER, STASKUNAS, TAYLOR, VAN ROY and ZEPNICK, cosponsored by Senator HANSEN. Referred to Committee on Urban and Local Affairs.

1 **AN ACT to create** 66.0410 of the statutes; **relating to:** regulating the resale of
2 tickets to entertainment or sporting events.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under this bill, a political subdivision (city, village, town, or county) may not enact an ordinance or adopt a resolution that prohibits the resale of tickets to an entertainment or sporting event if the resale price is equal to or less than the ticket's face value. If a political subdivision has in effect an ordinance or resolution that is inconstant with this bill, such an ordinance or resolution does not apply and may not be enforced.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1.** 66.0410 of the statutes is created to read:
4 **66.0410 Local regulation of ticket reselling.** (1) **DEFINITIONS.** In this
5 section:
6 (a) "Political subdivision" means a city, village, town, or county.

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1 (b) "Ticket" means a ticket that is sold to an entertainment or sporting event.

2 (2) RESELLING OF TICKETS. (a) A political subdivision may not enact an
3 ordinance or adopt a resolution prohibiting the resale of any ticket for an amount
4 that is equal to or less than the ticket's face value. , rule ,

5 (b) If a political subdivision has in effect on the effective date of this subsection
6 [revisor inserts date] an ordinance or resolution that is inconsistent with par. (a),
7 the ordinance or resolution does not apply and may not be enforced.
