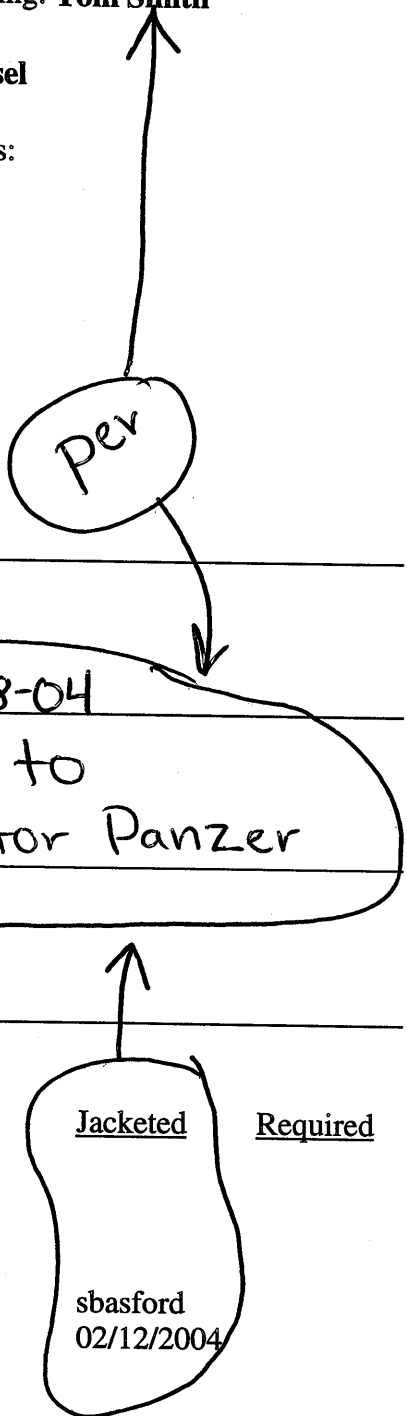

TO 2003 ASSEMBLY BILL 668

- 1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:
- 2 ✓ 1. Page 18, line 14: delete that line and substitute:
- 3 "SECTION 32c. 108.04 (16) (d) of the statutes is created to read:"
- 4 ✓ 2. Page 18, line 22: delete lines 22 to 25 and substitute:
- 5 "SECTION 32g. 108.04 (16) (e) of the statutes is created to read:
- 6 108.04 (16) (e) The department shall charge to the fund's balancing account the
- 7 cost of benefits paid to an individual that are otherwise chargeable to the account of
- 8 an employer that is subject to the contribution requirements of ss. 108.17 and 108.18
- 9 if the individual receives benefits based on the application of par. (d).
- 10 SECTION 32r. 108.04 (16) (e) of the statutes, as affected by 2003 Wisconsin Act
- 11 (this act), is amended to read:
- 12 108.04 (16) (e) The department shall charge to the fund's balancing account the
- 13 cost of benefits paid to an individual that are otherwise chargeable to the account of

1 an employer that is subject to the contribution requirements of ss. 108.17 and 108.18
2 if the individual receives benefits based on the application of par. (b), (c) 2., or (d).”.

3 ✓ **3.** Page 23, line 1: delete lines 1 to 18.

4 ✓ **4.** Page 24, line 6: delete lines 6 to 15.

5 ✓ **5.** Page 35, line 7: after that line insert:

6 “(3x) CLAIMS BY CLAIMANTS ENROLLED IN CERTAIN TRAINING PLANS. Section 108.04
7 (16) (d) of the statutes, as created by this act, and SECTION 68 (3x) of this act apply
8 notwithstanding section 108.04 (16) (b) and (c), 2001 stats.”.

9 ✓ **6.** Page 35, line 25: delete that line and substitute “of 2004.”.

10 ✓ **7.** Page 36, line 1: delete lines 1 to 24 and substitute:

11 “(2x) The renumbering and amendment of section 108.04 (2) (a) 3. of the
12 statutes and the creation of section 108.04 (2) (a) 3. a. to c. of the statutes first apply
13 with respect to weeks of unemployment beginning on June 27, 2004.

14 (3x) The creation of section 108.04 (16) (e) of the statutes first applies with
15 respect to weeks of unemployment beginning on December 30, 2001.

16 (4x) The treatment of sections 108.02 (25s) and 108.04 (7) (h) and (16) (a)
17 (intro.), 1. to 4., and 5., (b), (c), and (d) of the statutes and the amendment of section
18 108.04 (16) (e) of the statutes first apply with respect to weeks of unemployment
19 beginning on the effective date of this subsection.

20 (5x) The treatment of section 108.09 (4) (c) of the statutes first applies with
21 respect to determinations issued under sections 108.09, 108.095, and 108.10 of the
22 statutes on the effective date of this subsection.

1 (6x) The treatment of sections 108.16 (3) (a) and (6m) (e) and 108.225 (1) (b),
2 (15), and (16) (intro.), (a), (am), (b), and (c) of the statutes first applies with respect
3 to levies issued on the effective date of this subsection.

4 (7x) The treatment of section 108.16 (8) (b) (intro.) and 2., (c) 4., (e) 4., and (f)
5 of the statutes first applies with respect to transfers of businesses occurring after
6 December 31, 2003.

7 (8x) The treatment of section 108.22 (2) (b) of the statutes first applies with
8 respect to satisfactions, releases, and withdrawals of warrants issued on the effective
9 date of this subsection.

10 **SECTION 69m. Effective dates.** This act takes effect on the first Sunday after
11 publication, except as follows:

12 (1x) The treatment of section 108.16 (6m) (a) of the statutes and the creation
13 of section 108.04 (16) (e) of the statutes take effect retroactively to December 30,
14 2001.”.
