

## 2003 ASSEMBLY BILL 467

**AN ACT relating to:** the traffic violation and registration program and making an appropriation.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

1       **SECTION 1. Nonstatutory provisions; transportation.**

2       (1) Notwithstanding section 16.42 (1) (e) of the statutes, in submitting  
3 information under section 16.42 of the statutes for purposes of the 2005–07 biennial  
4 budget bill, the department of transportation shall submit a dollar amount for the  
5 appropriation under section 20.395 (5) (cq) of the statutes that is \$13,300 less than  
6 the total amount appropriated under section 20.395 (5) (cq) of the statutes for the  
7 2004–05 fiscal year, before submitting any information relating to any increase or  
8 decrease in the dollar amount for that appropriation for the 2005–07 fiscal biennium.

**ASSEMBLY BILL 467****SECTION 2****1 SECTION 2. Appropriation changes.**

2 (1) In the schedule under section 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation  
3 to the department of transportation under section 20.395 (5) (cq) of the statutes, as  
4 affected by the acts of 2003, the dollar amount is increased by \$41,600 for fiscal year  
5 2003–04 and the dollar amount is increased by \$60,200 for fiscal year 2004–05 to  
6 increase funding for the traffic violation and registration program.

**7 SECTION 3. Effective date.**

8 (1) This act takes effect on February 1, 2004, or on the first day of the first  
9 month beginning after publication, whichever is later.
