The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION #.

Section #. 348.27 (7m) of the statutes is amended to read:

348.27 (7m) THREE-VEHICLE COMBINATIONS. The department may issue an annual or consecutive month permit for the movement of a 3-vehicle combination consisting of a towing vehicle and, in order by weight, with the lighter of the towed vehicles as the 3rd vehicle in the 3-vehicle combination unless not structurally possible, a mobile home or camping trailer and a boat trailer, motorcycle trailer, personal watercraft trailer exall-terrain vehicle trailer, if the overall length of the combination of vehicles does not exceed 60 feet and the towed vehicles are for the use of the operator of the towing vehicle. AN ACT to amend 348.27 (7m) of the statutes; relating to: golf cart trailers as

towed vehicles in 3-vehicle combinations.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, the Department of Transportation (DOT) may issue annual or consecutive month permits that authorize a person to operate certain three—vehicle combinations that consist of the following vehicles:

- 1. A towing vehicle.
- 2. A mobile home or camping trailer.
- 3. A boat trailer, motorcycle trailer, personal watercraft trailer, or all-terrain vehicle trailer.

The towed vehicles must be for the use of the permittee and the overall length of the three–vehicle combination may not exceed 60 feet.

This bill permits DOT to issue such permits for three-vehicle combinations that have a towed vehicle described in item 3 that is a golf cart trailer.
