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

Pete,

As we discussed, I understood what you wanted for the amendment to AB-274 to match the "no permit" part of SB-159, but wasn't sure what kind of language juggling would be necessary.

I have now looked at the matter. The Assembly adopted a substitute amendment (ASA1 to AB-274), instead of the text of the actual bill AB-274. This sub was drafted to *remove* the permit requirement so that it actually matched this part of SB-159. The catch is that the sub, as drafted, is not what the assembly actually passed. The assembly also adopted an amendment (AA1 to ASA1 to AB-274) which put back in the permit requirement.

One option for you (the senate) would be to simply non-concur in AA1 to ASA1 to AB-274.

The other option would be to amend the bill to remove AA1 to ASA1 to AB-274. In either event, what you would be sending back to the assembly would be ASA1 to AB-274. I will go ahead and draft the amendment, but if you think that you don't want it (because you will just non-concur in the assembly), please let me know so I can drop the request. Aaron

7 regardless of the highways to be used. The department may designate the routes
8 that may be used by the permittee. The fee for an annual permit under this
9 subsection is \$40. The fee for a consecutive month permit under this subsection shall
10 be determined in the manner provided in s. 348.25 (8) (bm), except that the \$40 fee
11 for an annual permit under this subsection shall be used in the computation."
