Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill increases, from \$3,000 to \$15,000, the level at which DOT may sell or donate state property without the approval of the Governor. It also references s.16.375, which authorizes DOA to petition for the transfer of property from the owning agency to DOA. To date, DOA has not used this authority. Consequently, it is estimated that the bill will have no fiscal effect on the Department.
