Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill increases, from \$3,000 to \$15,000, the level at which DOT may sell or donate DOT surplus property without the approval of the Governor. It is estimated that the bill will have no fiscal effect on the Department but will allow for greater efficiency in processing surplus land sales by minimizing the number of days per parcel that is needed for approval.

In FY 2003 130 parcels of surplus land were sold. Of those 130 parcels, 31 were sold for between \$3,000 and \$15,000.
