

2003 ASSEMBLY BILL 777

AN ACT to amend 218.0114 (1) and 218.0119 (4) of the statutes; **relating to:**
unlicensed motor vehicle dealers, motor vehicle salespersons, and sales finance
companies, and providing a penalty.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

1 **SECTION 1.** 218.0114 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:
2 218.0114 (1) No motor vehicle dealer, motor vehicle salesperson or sales
3 finance company may engage in business as a motor vehicle dealer, motor vehicle
4 salesperson or sales finance company in this state without a license therefor as
5 provided in ss. 218.0101 to 218.0163. If any motor vehicle dealer acts as a motor
6 vehicle salesperson, he or she shall secure a motor vehicle salesperson's license in
7 addition to a motor vehicle dealer license. Every motor vehicle dealer shall be

1 responsible for the licensing of every motor vehicle salesperson in his or her employ.
2 Any person violating this subsection may be ~~fined~~ required to forfeit not less than
3 \$500 nor more than \$5,000.

4 **SECTION 2.** 218.0119 (4) of the statutes is amended to read:

5 218.0119 (4) Any dealer, distributor, manufacturer or transporter who fails to
6 comply with the requirements of this section may be ~~fined not more than \$200 or~~
7 ~~imprisoned for not more than 6 months or both~~ required to forfeit not less than \$100
8 nor more than \$200.

9 **SECTION 3. Initial applicability.**

10 (1) This act first applies to violations that occur on the effective date of this
11 subsection.
