renumbered 13.489 (1g)

1 **AN ACT** ^{Regen} *to renumber and amend* 13.489 (1m) (a); *to amend* 13.489 (4) (a) 1. a.
2 and b.; and *to create* 13.489 (4) (c), 13.489 (5), 13.489 (6) and 85.052 of the
3 statutes; **relating to:** major highway projects and the transportation projects
4 commission.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

5 **SECTION** ~~11~~ ^B 13.489 (1m) (a) of the statutes is renumbered 13.489 (1c), and
6 13.489 (1c) (intro.), as renumbered, is amended to read:
7 13.489 (1c) (intro.) In this subsection section:
8 **SECTION 2.** 13.489 (4) (a) 1. a. and b. of the statutes are amended to read:
9 13.489 (4) (a) 1. a. The commission determines that, within 6 years after the
10 first July 1 after the date on which the commission recommends approval of the
11 project, construction will be commenced on all projects enumerated under s. 84.013
12 (3) and on the project recommended for approval and the commission has been

1 notified that a final environmental impact statement or environmental assessment
2 for the project has been approved by the federal highway administration.

3 b. The report recommending approval of the project is accompanied by a
4 financing proposal that, if implemented, would provide funding in an amount
5 sufficient to ensure that construction will commence on all projects enumerated
6 under s. 84.013 (3) and on the project within 6 years after the first July 1 after the
7 date on which the commission recommends approval of the project and the
8 commission has been notified that a final environmental impact statement or
9 environmental assessment for the project has been approved by the federal highway
10 administration.

11 **SECTION 3.** 13.489 (4) (c) of the statutes is created to read:

12 13.489 (4) (c) No project may be enumerated under s. 84.013 (3) or approved
13 under s. 84.013 (6) unless the commission recommends approval, with or without
14 modifications, of the project under par. (a) or, with respect to a project under s. 84.013
15 (6m), designates the project under par. (b).

16 **SECTION 4.** 13.489 (5) of the statutes is created to read:

17 13.489 (5) DEPARTMENT TO REPORT PROJECT STATUS AND COSTS. (a) By February
18 1, 2005, and ^{every 6 months} ~~annually~~ thereafter, the department of transportation shall submit a
19 report to the commission that does all of the following:

20 1. Summarizes the current status of each project submitted by the department
21 that is under consideration by the commission under s. 13.489, including any project
22 approved by the commission under sub. (1m) (d), and of each project enumerated
23 under s. 84.013 (3) or approved under s. 84.013 (6).

24 2. For each project specified under subd. 1., identifies all actual and estimated
25 project costs, itemized by major cost categories, as of the date of preparation of the

1 report. To the extent feasible, the department shall separately track and report the
2 costs of environmental assessments, compliance, and mitigation.

3 (b) All project information included in any report required under this
4 subsection shall be reported on both a cumulative basis from the inception of the
5 project and on an updated basis for the period since the department's last report
6 under this subsection.

7 **SECTION 5.** 13.489 (6) of the statutes is created to read:

8 **13.489 (6) DEPARTMENT TO MAKE INFORMATION AVAILABLE.** Notwithstanding s.
9 19.35, the department of transportation shall make all of the following information
10 available to the public, including making the information available at no charge on
11 the department's Internet site, within the following time periods:

12 (a) Any report prepared by the department for the commission under sub. (5)
13 shall be available within 5 business days of the report's completion and transmittal
14 to the commission.

15 (b) Any materials or documents prepared by the department, except the
16 department's recommendations, for use at a meeting of the commission shall be
17 available at least 2 business days prior to the meeting.

18 (c) Any other information directed by the commission to be made available by
19 the department under this subsection shall be available within the time specified by
20 the commission.

21 **SECTION 6.** 85.052 of the statutes is created to read:

22 **85.052 Change management system for major highway projects.** The
23 department shall develop and implement a change management system for
24 providing fiscal and management oversight for all major highway projects funded
25 from any appropriation specified in s. 84.013 (2) (a).
