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




Gordon,

Sen. Brown would like to request an amendment to SB 410, which relates to fire dues. (Jeff Kuesel suggested contacting you.) He would like the Department of Commerce to be required to promulgate a rule that defines "administrative expenses" for purposes of s. 20.143(3)(La). I think you might want to place it in a new subsection in s. 101.573. Also, a reference would be needed to rule-making in the relating clause.

We didn't talk about timing of the rule, but it is probably reasonable to require that it be submitted to the Rules Clearinghouse within 6 months after the effective date of the bill. (I cc'ed Melissa from Sen. Brown's office so that she can contact you if a different deadline is desired.)

The bill is on the Senate calendar today.

**SENATE AMENDMENT ,
TO 2003 SENATE BILL 410**

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 ✓ 1. Page 1, line 2: after "program" insert ", defining administrative expenses"
3 for purposes of fire prevention and fire dues administration, and requiring the
4 exercise of rule-making authority".

5 ✓ 2. Page 2, line 1: delete that line and substitute:

6 "SECTION 1g. 101.573 (5) of the statutes is created to read:

7 101.573 (5) The department shall promulgate a rule defining "administrative
8 expenses" for purposes of s. 20.143 (3) (La).

9 SECTION 1m. 101.575 (4) (a) 1. of the statutes is amended to read:".

10 ✓ 3. Page 2, line 14: after that line insert:

11 "SECTION 2m. Nonstatutory provisions.

12 (1) FIRE PREVENTION AND FIRE DUES ADMINISTRATION. The department of
13 commerce shall submit in proposed form the rules required under section 101.573 (5)

1 of the statutes, as created by this act, to the legislative council staff under section
2 227.15 (1) of the statutes no later than the first day of the 6th month beginning after
3 the effective date of this subsection.”.

4 ✓ 4. Page 2, line 16: delete “This act” and substitute “FIRE DUES DISTRIBUTION.
5 The treatment of section 101.575 (4) (a) 1. and 2. of the statutes”.

6 ✓ 5. Page 2, line 19: delete “This act” and substitute “FIRE DUES DISTRIBUTION.
7 The treatment of section 101.575 (4) (a) 1. and 2. of the statutes”.

“SECTION 4m. Effective dates. This act takes effect on the day after publication, except as follows:”.*
