

2003 SENATE BILL 436

1 **AN ACT** *to amend* 20.395 (5) (hq), 110.20 (6) (a) 1. and 110.20 (6) (a) 3.; and *to*
2 **create** 110.215 of the statutes; **relating to:** motor vehicle emission inspections
3 and creating an equipment grant program, extending the time limit for
4 emergency rule procedures, providing an exemption from emergency rule
5 procedures, providing an exemption from rule-making procedures, granting
6 rule-making authority, and making an appropriation.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

7 **SECTION 1g.** 20.395 (5) (hq) of the statutes is amended to read:
8 20.395 (5) (hq) *Motor vehicle emission inspection and maintenance program;*
9 *contractor costs and equipment grants; state funds.* The amounts in the schedule to
10 provide for contracts for the operation of inspection stations under s. 110.20 and for
11 the motor vehicle emission control equipment grant program under s. 110.215.

1 **SECTION 1m.** 110.20 (6) (a) 1. of the statutes is amended to read:

2 110.20 **(6)** (a) 1. For a nonexempt vehicle required to be registered on an annual
3 or other periodic basis in this state, within the period of time specified by the
4 department under sub. (9) (d) prior to renewal of registration in the ~~2nd~~ 4th year
5 after the nonexempt vehicle's model year and every 2 years thereafter, except as
6 provided in sub. (9) (j).

7 **SECTION 2.** 110.20 (6) (a) 3. of the statutes is amended to read:

8 110.20 **(6)** (a) 3. For a nonexempt vehicle that is registered under s. 341.26 (2m),
9 owned by the United States or subject to one-time registration, at any time during
10 the ~~2nd~~ 4th year following the nonexempt vehicle's model year and every 2 years
11 thereafter.

12 **SECTION 2m.** 110.215 of the statutes is created to read:

13 **110.215 Motor vehicle emission control equipment grant program.**
14 From the appropriation under s. 20.395 (5) (hq), the department shall, in
15 consultation with the department of natural resources, develop and administer a
16 program to provide grants for the purchase and installation of oxidation catalyst
17 mufflers on school buses customarily kept in counties identified in s. 110.20 (5). The
18 department shall adopt rules to implement and administer this section, including
19 procedures, standards, and criteria for awarding and distributing the grants.

20 **SECTION 2r. Nonstatutory provisions.**

21 (1) The department of transportation shall submit in proposed form the rules
22 required under section 110.215 of the statutes, as created by this act, to the
23 legislative council staff under section 227.15 (1) of the statutes no later than the first
24 day of the 4th month beginning after the effective date of this subsection.
