Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, a person who holds a valid motor vehicle operator's license issued by another state or jurisdiction must surrender this out-of-state operator's license to the Department of Transportation (DOT) prior to issuance by DOT of a Wisconsin operator's license. Within 30 days after application to DOT, DOT must return any out-of-state license to the state of issuance, together with information that the applicant is now licensed in this state or has been refused a license by this state, as applicable.

This bill requires that, in lieu of returning an out-of-state license to the state of issuance, DOT must, within 30 days following a person's licensure in this state, destroy any surrendered license and report to the state of issuance that the person is now licensed in this state.
