2003 WISCONSIN ACT 221

AN ACT *to amend* 343.11 (2) of the statutes; **relating to:** issuance of operators' licenses to persons previously licensed in another state.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 343.11 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:

343.11 (2) ~~Upon the expiration of~~ Within 30 days following the application licensure in this state, the department shall ~~return~~ destroy all surrendered licenses and

report to the issuing department ~~together with information jurisdiction~~ that the licensee is now licensed in this state ~~or has been refused a license by this state, whichever the case may be.~~

SECTION 2. Initial applicability.

(1) This act first applies to persons licensed by the department of transportation on the effective date of this subsection.
