

2003 ASSEMBLY BILL 533

AN ACT *to amend* 804.03 (3) of the statutes; **relating to:** contracts with persons who take depositions.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

1 **SECTION 1.** 804.03 (3) of the statutes is amended to read:
2 804.03 **(3)** DISQUALIFICATION FOR INTEREST. No deposition shall may be taken
3 before a person who is a party to the action or a relative or employee or attorney, or
4 counsel of any of the parties, or is a relative or employee of such attorney or counsel,
5 or is financially interested in the action. No deposition may be taken before a person
6 who has entered into a contract for court reporting services unless the contract is
7 limited to a particular action or incident. This subsection does not apply to a person
