1 AN ACT to create 348.07 (2) (im) of the statutes; relating to: trailers used to
2 transport livestock.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, with limited exceptions, no one may operate a single vehicle that exceeds 40 feet in length without obtaining a permit from the Department of Transportation.

This bill creates an exception for a trailer that is used to transport livestock and that does not exceed 53 feet in length.

For further information see the *state and local* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 SECTION 1. 348.07 (2) (im) of the statutes is created to read:

4 348.07 (2) (im) 53 feet for a trailer transporting livestock.
