12	a vehicle that is equipped with a dump body and that is carrying any load extending

above the top of the dump body unless the vehicle is so loaded and covered as to

- prevent the load from dropping or sifting from the vehicle. This paragraph does not apply to a person while temporarily operating a vehicle on a highway between fields or between a farm and a field.
 - (c) This subsection does not apply to the application of a bulk material to a highway for the purpose of maintenance or construction of the highway.".
